For Publishers

When you want information about Finnish literature,

you can

- check FILI's website publication 100 or So Books from Finland for book picks
- · meet literary agents and FILI representatives at book fairs
- subscribe to FILI's newsletter.
- visit FILI's translation database for details of works already published in translation and translation rights that have been sold
- · check FILI's statistics of the most widely translated Finnish books

Before you buy translation rights,

you can

- · be in touch with literary agents, see the contact list on our website
- · search for translators or readers on the Kääntöpiiri website
- apply for a grant to help commission a reader's report on a Finnish book written in Finnish, Finland-Swedish or Sámi

Once you have purchased translation rights,

you can

- apply for translation and printing grants from FILI for translating Finnish literature into other languages
- find application instructions and forms on our website
- the application periods are 1 January 1 February,
 1 April 1 May and 1 October 1 November each year
- grant decisions are announced approximately six weeks after the end of the application period, and the books can only be printed after the grant decisions have been made

When the translated book has been published,

you can

• apply for a promotional grant to organise an author visit or tour
